The children have continued to learn about Autumn this week. Some of them have been 'baking' in our home corner, whilst others have been experimenting with using different vegetables to create their own printed pictures. We have had some fantastic discussions about the changes taking place in nature as we move into Autumn and the importance of the Harvest festival.

The children have been comparing size, mass, amounts and capacity during their maths learning this week. They are getting very good at using specific language to help them make comparisons such as, more, fewer, taller, shorter, full, empty etc. Please continue to develop this language at home and upload any examples to Tapestry.
