

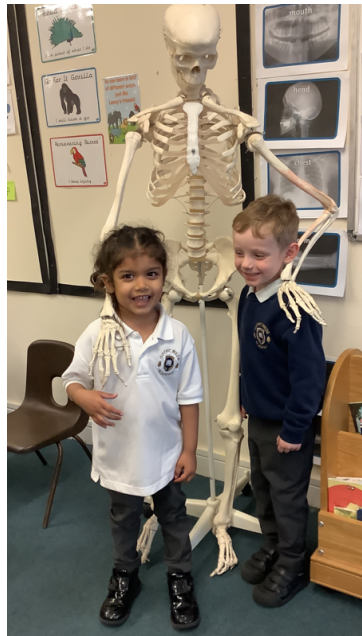


Friday 22nd October
