Reading Corner

Every fortnight we will be looking at a different reading skill.

This week our skill focus is: Word Meaning

Children in key stage one and two need to be able to explain the meaning of words or groups of words in the text.

Words can have lots of different meanings. Always find the target word in the text to check that you understand how it is being used in the sentence.

It helps to read the words that come before and after the target word.

Try swapping the word with a similar word you know. Does this change the meaning of the sentence?

Questions to support your child with word meaning:

Can you find the word _____? Have you heard that word before? What might it mean? Which other words in the text could help

you? What word could you use instead of _____?
