

Ash and Oak Star Challenge

Our Star Challenge this term is called 'My family'. This half term, the children will be learning to use vocabulary that enables them to compare and contrast so that they can discuss similarities and differences between their households. To supplement our topic 'All about me' we would like the children to tell us about the people in their immediate family and their roles in society. In particular, they could tell us about the jobs that they do, clubs that they belong to and any volunteering or community groups that they are part of. The children will be expected to share this information with the class or a small group. They can choose to present this in any way they wish. Some suggestions are that they could do this by:

- Creating a portrait
- Making a family album.
- Making a model
- Creating a collage

This work should be handed in by **18th December** and is best tackled in small sessions throughout the term rather than one evening! We will use the grid below as the basis for awarding stars. A possible nine stars are available! It is perfectly acceptable, in fact preferable, for you to work *together* with your child to produce their 'Star Challenge'. However, we do encourage the final piece to be as much of the children's own work as possible and this will be taken into account when awarding stars for presentation (it is easy to spot work that hasn't been done by a child!). We will ask the children to share their work with the rest of the class and they will be asked to tell the children about their family and what they do.
