This week the children started our first English topic from the Write Stuff scheme of work. This scheme has been successful across the rest of the school and we are excited to start using it this term in Reception. The children have enjoyed meeting 'Grandma Fantastic' who has introduced the children to a range of exciting vocabulary. The children have then worked together to use some of these words in guided sentences to describe the movement of an aeroplane.

This week in handwriting the children were introduced to the letters u, w and e. It would be great to encourage your child to practise these letters at home either when writing or using our Letter join programme. Please also continue to practise last week's letters, i,l and t. We would love to see any examples of handwriting on Tapestry.

This week in Forest School the children enjoyed exploring the frozen water, using the large loose parts to create a rocket and sip hot chocolate around basecamp.
