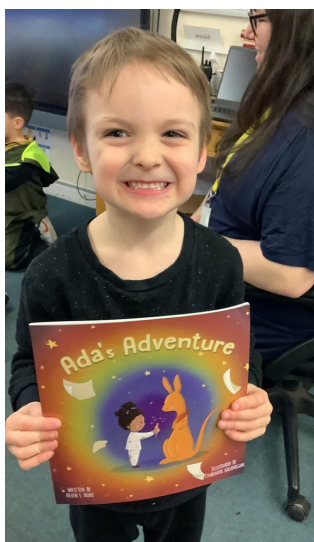




Friday 8th March
