## ACORN NURSERY SEPTEMBER SPACES AVAILABLE

We still have places in our Acorn Nursery for children wishing to start their learning journey in September. We run two sessions for the children to spend 15 hours in Acorn class. Acorn A is the beginning of the week and the children attend all day on Monday, Tuesday and for two hours on Wednesday morning. Acorn B is the end of the week and the children attend for two hours on Wednesday afternoon and all-day Thursday and Friday. We accept children the September term after they turn 3 so if you would like your child to join us for 15 funded hours per week, please contact the school office.

## MEDICATION

In line with our policy 'supporting pupils with medical conditions' where a child is on prescribed medication to be taken three times or fewer per day, this should be done by parents out of school time. The schools will only administer prescribed medication that is to be taken four or more times per day.
