Early Years

We are extremely proud of our Early Years provision in our Acorn Nursery Class and in Reception.

We believe that children learn best through a combination of child-initiated play, structured play activities and adult-focused teaching sessions.

Children have free access to the indoor and outside areas, where there are resources and activities to develop all areas of learning.

Staff carefully observe and support the children during their child-initiated play in order to identify their interests and next steps for learning.

Short, daily, adult-focused teaching sessions enable the children to develop their skills in areas such as Phonics and Maths, as well as other areas of learning.



Our Curriculum

We place a strong emphasis on Maths and English, with these subjects being taught every day.

In particular, early phonics and reading is a priority and the expert delivery of our phonics scheme gives children the skills they need to go on to become confident readers.

We are extremely proud that **92% of Year 1 children passed the Phonics Screening Check in 2024.** This is

significantly above the 2023 national average of 79%.

The children enjoy a range of other subjects too, which provide a rich and broad curriculum.

We tie all learning together through offering enriching experiences, such as trips and whole school learning events including Arts Around the World Week, Science Week, Wellbeing Week, World Book Day and Anti-Bullying Week.



Forest School

We are incredibly fortunate to have a Forest School at Gothic Mede Academy.

Forest School is a child-centred learning process, providing learner inspired and hands-on experiences in the natural environment.

We know that Forest School offers numerous benefits to the children, including developing their social skills, physical skills and knowledge.

It also increases a child's confidence and resilience as they problem solve and learn to manage risks.



Family Support

We feel it is important to work in partnership with parents and carers to ensure the best outcomes for children.

From time to time, everyone will need some extra advice and support to help them meet the needs of their child, enabling more positive family relationships to develop and ensuring their child achieves the most they can out of life.

Our Family Support Worker is on hand to work with families or to signpost them to external agencies for further family support.

★ **We offer an extensive range of extracurricular activities.**

After-school clubs include choir, art club and tag rugby.

In addition, we run the Junior Duke Award Scheme, which helps to increase independence, confidence and resilience.

External agencies help us to provide much more to our pupils, including Mindful Magic, Happy Little Yogi, Disco Ducks, BX Dance and Multisports.
