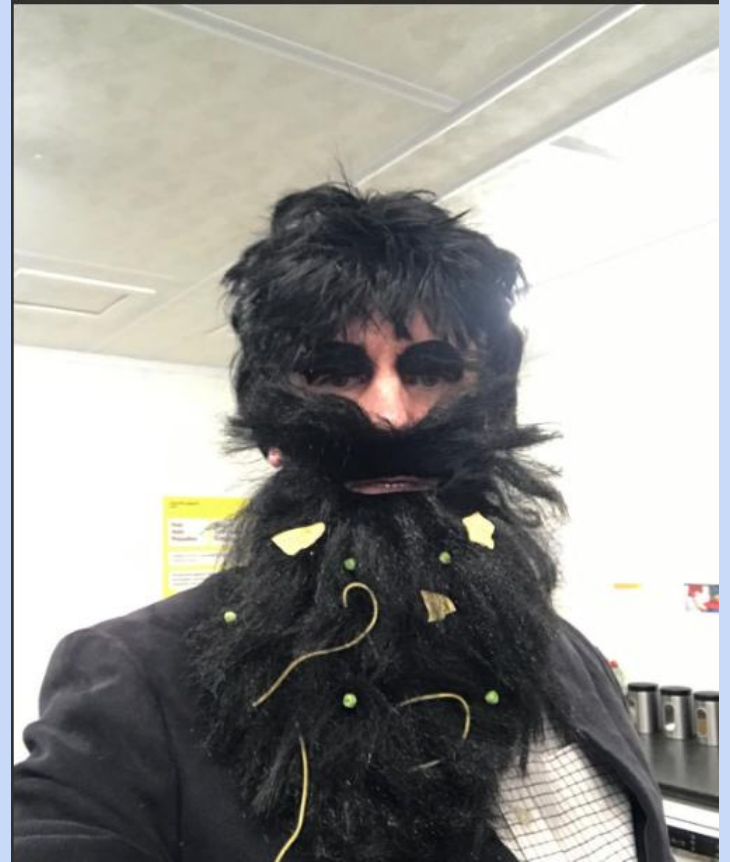

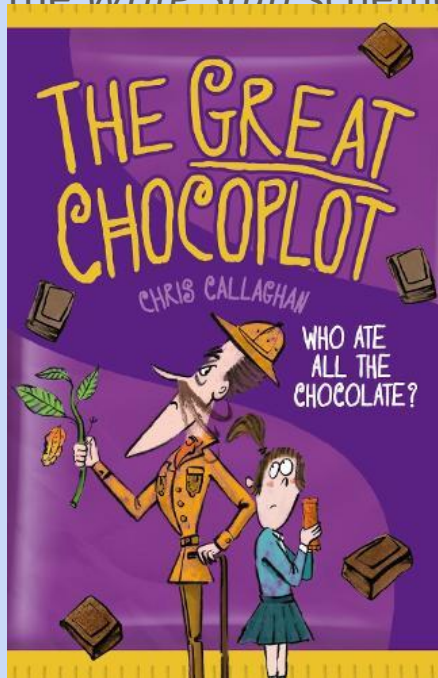

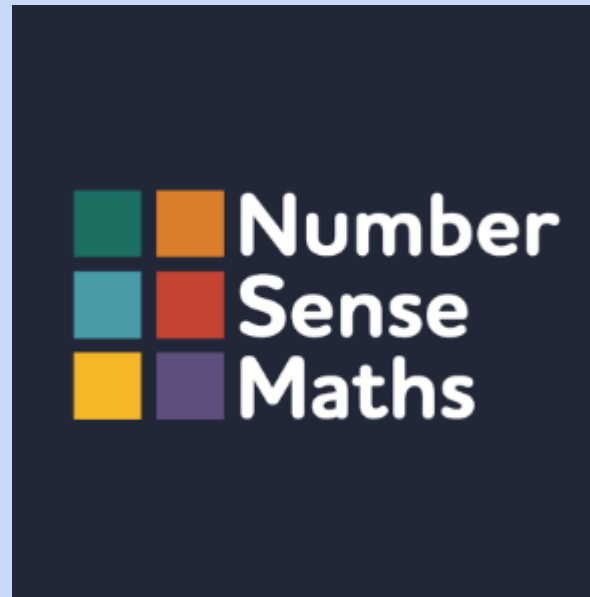
What we have planned for Year Four
