In School we have been talking about lots of different celebrations. We have discussed how some of these are religious and some are non-religious celebrations. We have already found out about Harvest, Halloween, Diwali, Bonfire night and Remembrance Sunday. This half term we will also learn about Hanukkah and Christmas.

We would like your child to share a special memory of a celebration they have taken part in. This may be a recent event such as attending a firework display for Bonfire night or a significant family event such a wedding.

We find that photos and/or objects are really useful to help your child to talk about their experiences. We encourage you to spend some time talking about this special memory at home so that your child feels confident to talk to the class. Together you could discuss:

What was the celebration they took part in?

How did they prepare for it?

What happened?

Where did they go?

What did they see?

Did they enjoy it? Why?
