

Spring Term Home Learning Handwriting

The children have been working really hard at learning how to form letters correctly. One of the ways you can support your child with becoming familiar with correct letter formation is through accessing our online subscription to letterjoin. This term we encourage you to access Letterjoin and practise the individual letters using a print handwriting style.

Attached you will find details guiding you through logging into the website. It is important that once you have logged in you select your child's class name (Oak or Ash) so that they practice the letters using the correct handwriting style that we teach in Reception.

As an extra challenge they could apply their learning to label pictures, write short phrases or sentences. This might be labelling a picture, writing a sign to go alongside their play, writing a card to a family member or friend etc. We encourage the children to use robot arms to sound out a word and then write down all the sounds they can hear. You can use the sound sheets that we gave out at parents evening to help if they can't remember how to make a sound. Please do share any writing on Tapestry.
