

## English curriculum objectives - year 3 autumn term.

As part of our COVID 19 recovery curriculum we will be revisiting many of the Year 2 National Curriculum objectives. To ensure that the children are secure in their understanding of the Year 2 knowledge we are implementing both band 2 and band 3 statements in our planning, this is with hopes to close the gaps created by the first lockdown.

### Band 2 reading objectives

- Develop pleasure and motivation in reading by making use of a variety of texts
- Develop pleasure in reading while thinking about the order in which events happen
- Develop pleasure in reading by re-telling our class stories
- Make inferences on the basis of what is said / done in the book they are reading independently

### Band 3 reading objectives

- Maintain a positive attitude to reading by being exposed to a wide range of texts
- Maintain a positive attitude to reading by understanding the layout and structure of the text they are reading
- Maintain a positive attitude to reading by reciting and performing familiar texts
- Answer questions about a text they are reading to promote understanding
- Refer to characters thoughts, feelings and actions to express the understanding of a text
- Develop comprehension by predicting what might happen next
- Identify different aspects of a text such as paragraphs, while being able to identify key information

### Band 2 writing objectives

- Write about real events, recording these simply and clearly
- Write poetry to generate stamina and interest in writing
- Write for different purposes to develop a positive attitude

- Consider what they are going to write about before beginning their work, by planning or verbalising their ideas
- Consider the key vocabulary and features before beginning their writing
- Make simple additions to their own work
- Read aloud what they have written with appropriate voice and tone
- Use present and past tense
- Use capital letters and full stops correctly
- Use question marks and exclamation marks appropriately
- Use commas in a list
- Use apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in a spelling

### Band 3 writing objectives

- Plan their writing by discussing texts which follow a similar structure and vocabulary
- Plan their ideas by discussing and recording ideas within a given structure
- Draft write and compose by rehearsing sentences orally and building a varied and rich vocabulary
- Draft and write by organising writing into paragraphs as a way of grouping material
- Draft and write a narrative creating settings and characters
- Evaluate and edit their work by assessing its effectiveness
- Express time by using before, after and while by producing an independent piece of writing
- Begin to use paragraphs as a way to group materials
- Proof read their work to check for spelling and punctuation errors
- Read their work aloud to a group or the whole class using appropriate use of their voice and tone
- Begin to use inverted commas correctly in their writing
